Students will also benefit from the school's wider facilities, including a 450-seater auditorium, a 50m Olympic-sized swimming pool, purpose-built science labs (for older students), a multi-purpose indoor sports hall, as well as other facilities for music, drama, dance, and art. The school also boasts a diverse international faculty, comprising highly qualified teachers who have graduated from top global universities and worked at schools around the world.

PRIMARY SCHOOL

The Primary School at Harrow International School Bengaluru offers an enriching and nurturing environment where young learners thrive. The world-class facilities and supportive atmosphere encourage curiosity, exploration, and growth from the very start of their educational journey.

With 60% international faculty and an 7:1 student-staff ratio, students enjoy personalised attention in their home room classes and benefit from the experience of our specialist teachers in Physical Education, Dance, and Sciences. Through the Global Perspectives programme, they gain an appreciation for both local cultures and those from around the world.

Harrow recognises the importance of encouraging children to develop language skills throughout their school journey. We therefore offer a comprehensive modern foreign language programme which allows our young learners to select from lessons in Mandarin Chinese, Hindi, Spanish, French, German and Korean. Lessons are taught by native speakers, hence ensuring that all students make good progress whether beginners or advanced in their selected language.

The school's state-of-the-art facilities, including exceptional amenities for swimming and other sports, as well as our performance auditorium, science labs, and performing arts studios, foster both academic and personal growth.

THE STRUCTURE OF THE SCHOOL DAY

Our Primary School offers a balanced, well-paced daily routine designed to provide both academic rigour and opportunities for creativity, sport and well-being.

- **Morning Arrival (7:45 onwards):** Students start arriving from 7:45 am onwards. Early arrivals may join a short yoga and stretching session to begin the day focused and calm.
- **Registration & Warm-up Activities:** Every morning, students participate in engaging Maths, English, and Well-being warm-ups during registration.
- **Core Learning Blocks:** Lessons span across English, Mathematics, Science, Humanities and Languages, with specialist teachers leading PE, Swimming, Music and Art.
- **Breaks:** Morning, lunch, and afternoon breaks give students time to enjoy our new playground and outdoor areas.



DAILY TIMETABLES

Timetables are tailored for each grade, ensuring each age group has an age-appropriate balance of lessons, CCAs and well-being sessions. Class teachers will share detailed timetables directly with families.

Nutritious, balanced meals are provided throughout the day.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (CCAS)

At Harrow Bengaluru, CCAs form an integral part of the Primary School experience.

- **Daily Schedule:** CCAs are held every day as part of their regular schedule
- **Range of Options:** From sports and performing arts to coding, creative clubs, and language-based CCAs such as The French Cartoon Club and Spanish Fiesta, enrich the learning experience.
- **Special Opportunities:** LAMDA (London Academy of Music and Dramatic Art) sessions are offered but are currently at full capacity due to limited spaces.

LANGUAGE LEARNING

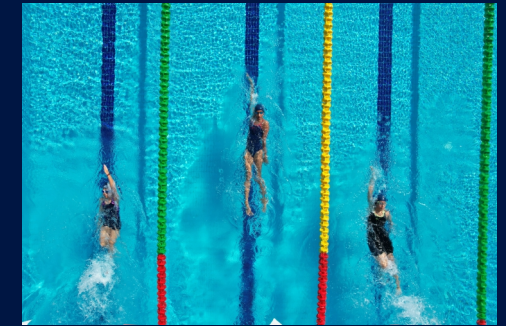
Language development forms the cornerstone of our curriculum.

- **Mandarin:** Compulsory for all pupils across the Primary School.
- **Language Tasters (Grades 4 & 5):** Pupils explore French, Spanish, German and Hindi on a rotational basis.
- **CCA Language Clubs:** French and Spanish clubs extend learning opportunities through fun, immersive activity-based experiences.
