Grading and Assessment

At our school, assessments from Year 6 to Year 12 are based on a criterion-referenced system. Academic performance is reported using an A* to U grading scale for Cambridge curricula, and a 1 to 7 scale for IBDP, reflecting percentage results from key assessments. Our reports provide a holistic view by including both academic and current grades. For university applications, we issue bespoke transcripts that detail final exam grades in each subject. Importantly, we do not use ranking for our students, ensuring that everyone is recognised for their own achievements.
